The purpose of this booklet is to provide you with information regarding the syllabi in the various subjects in year 10.

The curriculum in Year 10 is divided into two parts - compulsory core subjects and optional subjects.

This year there are three option groups and it is very important that you make wise choices. You must:

- Ask for advice from Subject Leaders, Subject Teachers, Form Teachers, Heads of Progress and Wellbeing, the Deputy Headteacher and the Headteacher.
- Ensure that you know the nature of the work in the various subjects.
- Ask for advice from the careers teacher and the careers officer since it might be necessary to study a particular subject in order to follow a particular career or a particular course at a University or College of Further/Higher Education.

Whatever subjects you choose, success will not be achieved without hard work. You must work diligently throughout the course and not leave your revision until the last minute.

Assessments/coursework are still important in some subjects. It is vital that they are completed to the highest standard possible. This may involve drafting and re-drafting work before producing the final version. You will require a great deal of self-discipline in order to complete the tasks by the closing dates.

Achieving good results in examinations is more important than ever since there is a shortage of job opportunities and therefore a great deal of competition for each vacancy. There is also more competition for places at Colleges of Further and Higher Education, which means that good grades are essential in order to be accepted.

I ask you to do your best in all subjects, that is, to work to the best of your ability.
A determined effort on your behalf will bring success.

THE CURRICULUM

The course of study your child follows in school is known as the Curriculum. The curriculum has to be broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated. A curriculum has breadth if it introduces a wide range of experience, knowledge and skills to the pupils.

It is necessary to allocate sufficient time to each area of the curriculum in order to ensure balance. The subject matter will be relevant in each area of the curriculum and should be taught in such a way as to link with the pupils' own experiences and to promote their development as well as to prepare them for adult life.

The curriculum is differentiated so that it provides for the learning needs of pupils in a way that ensures that the curriculum is accessible to all. What is taught needs to be matched to the ability and aptitudes of the pupils.

The learning programmes must show progression. The curriculum consists of a number of subjects together with cross-curricular matters.

The subjects are further classified into **Core** and **Optional subjects**.

Religious Education

The basic curriculum must include a provision for Religious Education for all pupils throughout the school. The Religious Education curriculum must reflect the Christian tradition of this country but should also take into account the teaching of other worldwide religions.

An act of worship must be part of the school day. Parents have the right to exclude their child from religious worship and religious education. Parents who wish to withdraw their children from Religious Education lessons or from the morning assembly must make such a request in writing.





ANGHENION DYSGU YCHWANEGOL

Er mwyn sicrhau bod y cwricwlwm ar gael i bob disgybl bydd yr ysgol yn darparu ar gyfer disgyblion ag anghenion dysgu ychwanegol. Yn unol â gofynion deddf newydd ADY 2021, bydd yr ysgol yn paratoi cynlluniau datblygu unigol ar gyfer disgyblion sydd yn cael eu hystried ag Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol. GWEITHGAREDDAU BYD GWAITH/PROFIAD GWAITH - MR O THOMAS

Bydd pob disgybl yng nghyfnod allweddol 4 yn cael cyfle i gymryd rhan mewn gweithgareddau Byd Gwaith yn yr ysgol. Bydd y profiadau hyn yn helpu'r disgyblion i ddeall gofynion cyflogwyr ac yn eu paratoi ar gyfer y newidiadau fydd yn eu hwynebu wrth iddynt symud o fyd ysgol i fyd gwaith.

ADDITIONAL LEARNING NEEDS

In order to ensure that the curriculum is accessible to all pupils, the school will cater for pupils with additional learning needs. In accordance with the requirements of the new ALN Act 2021, the school will prepare individual development plans for pupils who are affected by Additional Learning Needs. The school will hold regular meetings with pupils and their parents in order to ensure the necessary provision and support.

CAREERS AND THE WORLD OF WORK - MR O THOMAS

All year Key Stage 4 pupils will follow a series of World of Work activities organised at the school. These experiences will be of value to the pupils when making decisions regarding their future careers. This will also help pupils to understand the requirements and expectations of future employers and will assist them in making the transition from school to the adult world of work.

BAGLORIAETH CYMRU

Ffocws canolog Bagloriaeth Cymru yng Nghyfnod Allweddol 4 yw darparu cyfrwng i rai 14-16 oed atgyfnerthu a meithrin sgiliau hanfodol a chyflogadwyedd.




Bydd y cymhwyster yn helpu disgyblion i baratoi ar gyfer y dyfodol drwy feithrin sgiliau, priodoleddau a mathau o ymddygiad a gaiff eu gwerthfawrogi gan addysgwyr ôl-16 a darpar gyflogwyr. Mae pwyslais Bagloriaeth Cymru ar ddysgu cymhwysol h.y. cafael a defnyddio amrywiaeth o sgiliau trosglwyddadwy.

Bydd yr ysgol yn cynnig profiad dysgu sy'n berthnasol i anghenion a gofynion y gweithle yn meithrin hyder, cymhelliant a blaengaredd dysgwyr, gan eu paratoi i ymuno â'r byd gwaith, i lwyddo yn y byd hwnnw ac i ddatblygu ynddo.

Mae Bagloriaeth Cymru yn seiliedig ar Dystysgrif Her Sgiliau ynghyd â Chymwysterau Atebol. Rhaid bodloni gofynion y Dystysgrif Her Sgiliau a'r Cymwysterau Atebol er mwyn cyflawni Bagloriaeth Cymru yn ei chyfanrwydd.

Mae'r Dystysgrif Her Sgiliau yn cynnwys pedair cydran a gaiff eu dilyn gan bob dysgwr:

- **Project Unigol**
- **Her Menter a Chyflogadwyedd**
- **Her Dinasyddiaeth Fyd-eang**
- **Her y Gymuned**



Bydd canlyniadau cyfunol y pedair cydran yn penderfynu p'un a gaiff y Dystysgrif Her Sgiliau ei dyfarnu ar lefel Genedlaethol neu Sylfaen. Bydd ffocws y Dystysgrif Her Sgiliau ar y sgiliau hanfodol a'r sgiliau cyflogadwyedd sydd eu hangen ar bobl ifanc yn eu bywydau yn y dyfodol a chaiff y sgiliau hyn eu meithrin a'u hasesu drwy Project Unigol a thair Her. Cynlluniwyd y Dystysgrif Her Sgiliau i gynnwys dysgu ac asesu a fydd yn ennyn brwd frydedd dysgwyr, yn ymgysylltu â hwy ac yn eu cymell yn yr ystafell ddosbarth, y gweithle a'r gymuned ehangach. Bydd gofyn i'r disgyblion ystyried sut y gallant wrth ddefnyddio'r dysg effeithio ar unigolion, cyflogwyr, y gymdeithas a'r amgylchedd. Lluniwyd y cymhwyster yn seiliedig ar y cysyniad o ddull dysgu trwy 'gynllunio, gwneud ac adolygu' lle caiff y dysgwyr eu cyflwyno i gyd-destun ar gyfer dysgu lle byddant yn cynllunio gweithgareddau, yn ymgymryd â gweithgareddau, yn adolygu deilliannau a'r hyn a ddysgir.

Mae'r Cymwysterau Atebol yn cynnwys dau gymhwyster TGAU gorfodol mewn Saesneg iaith neu Gymraeg iaith ynghyd â Mathemateg - Rhifedd. Mae angen tri chymhwyster TGAU arall hefyd, y gall dau ohonynt fod yn gymwysterau cyfwerth. Er mwyn bodloni gofynion Bagloriaeth Genedlaethol Cymru, rhaid ennill gradd A*-C ym mhob un o'r pum Cymhwyster Atebol. Yn yr un modd, er mwyn bodloni Bagloriaeth Sylfaen Cymru, rhaid ennill gradd A*-G yn y Cymwysterau Atebol.

Nod Bagloriaeth Cymru yw galluogi dysgwyr i feithrin a dangos dealltwriaeth o sgiliau hanfodol a chyflogadwyedd a hyfedredd o ran y sgiliau hynny. Dyma'r sgiliau y mae cyflogwyr ac addysgwyr cam nesaf yn eu gwerthfawrogi ac sydd eu hangen ar ddysgwyr ar gyfer dysgu, gwaith a bywyd.



THE WELSH BACCALAUREATE

The central focus of the Welsh Baccalaureate at Key Stage 4 is to provide a vehicle for 14-16 year olds to consolidate and develop essential and employability skills. The qualification will help pupils to prepare for their future by developing skills, attributes and behaviours valued by post-16 educators and potential employers. The emphasis in the Welsh Baccalaureate is on applied learning i.e. acquiring and applying a range of transferable skills. The School will offer a learning experience relevant to the needs and demands of the workplace that will develop pupils' confidence, drive and initiative, preparing them to enter, succeed and progress in the world of work.

The Welsh Baccalaureate is based on a Skills Challenge Certificate alongside Supporting Qualifications. The requirements of both the Skills Challenge Certificate and Supporting Qualifications must be met in order to achieve the overarching Welsh Baccalaureate.

The Skills Challenge Certificate consists of four components which are followed by all pupils:

- **Individual Project**
- **Enterprise and Employability Challenge**
- **Global Citizenship Challenge**
- **Community Challenge**



The combined outcomes of the four components will determine whether the Skills Challenge Certificate is awarded at National or Foundation level. The Skills Challenge Certificate has been designed to include learning and assessment which will enthuse, engage and motivate pupils in the classroom, the workplace and the wider community. Pupils will be required to consider how the application of their learning may impact on individuals, employers, society and the environment. The qualification has been devised around the concept of a 'plan, do, and review' approach to learning where pupils are introduced to a context for learning, plan activities, carry out activities, review outcomes and learning.

The Supporting Qualifications include two mandatory GCSEs of English Language or Welsh Language together with Mathematics-Numeracy. A further three GCSEs are also required, of which two may be of equivalent qualifications. To meet the National Welsh Baccalaureate requirements all five of the Supporting Qualifications must be achieved at grades A*-C. Similarly, for the Foundation Welsh Baccalaureate the Supporting Qualifications must be achieved at grades A*-G.

The Welsh Baccalaureate aims to enable pupils to develop and demonstrate an understanding of and proficiency in essential and employability skills. These are the skills that employers and next stage educators value and which pupils need for learning, work and life.

Papurau Arholiad Haenedig

Er bod TGAU yn arholiad sengl sy'n cwmpasu'r holl ystod gallu, mae papurau haenog ar gael mewn rhai pynciau. Mae graddau arbennig wedyn yn gyfyngedig i'r haenau a'r haen uchaf yn galluogi'r disgyblion i gyrraedd A* - C gan amlaf. Mae'r penderfyniad ynglŷn â pha haen i osod disgybl arno yn un bwysig a bydd cyfle i rieni drafod y mater hwn gyda'r athro pwnc neu'r penneth adran yn ystod Nosweithiau Rhieni.

Gwaith Cwrs/Asesiad Dan Reolaeth

Mewn nifer o bynciau mae angen i ddisgyblion gwblhau gwaith cwrs/asesiadau dan reolaeth fel rhan o'i hasesiad terfynol. Mae'r wybodaeth ynglŷn â'r gyfran o farciau sydd yn cael ei ddyfarnu i waith cwrs/asesiad dan reolaeth wedi ei gynnwys dan y pwnc penodol. Mae'n bwysig fod disgyblion yn ennill cymaint o farciau â phosibl am yr asesiadau yma ac felly bydd angen sylw manwl a chynllunio gofalus.

EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS

What is GCSE?

The General Certificate of Secondary Education - the GCSE has been confirmed as the chief means of assessing the National Curriculum at Key Stage 4. The requirements of the National Curriculum therefore determine much of the content of the new GCSE syllabuses. The GCSE has a single scale of grades from A* to G.

Tiered Exam Papers

Although the GCSE is a single examination system covering the whole ability range, in some subjects there are different tiers of papers. Each tier has a restricted number of grades with the higher tier for candidates likely to obtain A* - C. The choice of tier is an important one and parents will be able to discuss this with the subject teacher or Head of Department during Parents Evenings.

Controlled Assessments/Coursework

In many subjects, pupils are required to complete controlled assessments/coursework as part of the final assessment. Information regarding the amount of marks carried by these assessments is given under the subject headings. It is important that pupils gain as many marks as possible from their controlled assessments and it will therefore need careful attention and planning.

Course Summary

This course fosters positive attitudes towards the Welsh language, its literary heritage and contemporary multi-media culture by encouraging an appreciation of the language and promoting its effective use. Welsh Language GCSE acknowledges oral, reading and written skills. We expect candidates to be inspired, motivated and challenged by pursuing a course that is broad and varied, valuable and enjoyable. They will develop their ability to use Welsh as knowledgeable and responsible citizens who will be able to speak, listen, read and write fluently, appropriately, effectively and critically for a wide range of personal, employment and social purposes. Candidates will be expected to respond to a wide variety of written subjects, including ones that are challenging and dynamic. They will develop the necessary knowledge and skills to make informed decisions on further education opportunities and career choices.

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1: Non-examination assessment

Oral - 30%

Task 1 (15%) - Individual Presentation based on Research (40 marks)

Individual presentation based on research, which may contain responses to questions, and feedback based on WJEC based themes.

Task 2 (15%) Response and Interaction (40 marks)

A group task based on written and/or visual stimulus provided by WJEC to engender discussion.

Unit 2: External Assessment

Reading and Writing - Describe, Narrative and Explain

35% 2 hours

Section A (15%) - Reading (30 marks)

Understanding at least one discussion, one directional and one persuasive text, to include unbroken and chunked extract subjects. The reading will be assessed by means of a series of structured questions. This section will also include an editing subject task, which will concentrate on understanding a short text at a word, sentence and subject level (2.5% of the whole competence).

Section B (20%) - Written (40 marks)

Two compulsory written tasks - one discursive and one persuasive.

Unit 3: External Assessment

Reading and Writing - Discuss, Persuade and Directional

35% 2 hours

Section A (15%) - Reading (30 marks)

Understand at least one discussion subject, one directional and one persuasive, to include unbroken and chunked extract subjects. The reading will be assessed by means of a series of structured questions.

Section B (20%) - Writing (40 marks)

One compulsory written task - discursive, and one compulsory written task - persuasive.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE



Examination Board - WJEC

Course Summary

The WJEC's course introduced in 2015 is the most challenging yet. With the removal of written coursework, and half of the marks for section B in both exam papers being awarded for communication and organisation (meaning, purpose, readers and structure) and half for writing accurately (language, grammar, punctuation and spelling), GCSE students must focus on improving their skills from the start. Students will need to respond to a wide range of written texts, demonstrating a sound understanding of the ways in which language is used to convey meanings and ideas, as well use language creatively and with precision.

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1 - Non-examination assessment (20%)

Task 1 (10%) – Individual Researched Presentation (40 marks) One individual, researched presentation, which may include responses to questions and feedback, based on WJEC set themes.

Task 2 (10%) – Responding and Interacting (40 marks) One group discussion to written and/or visual stimuli provided by WJEC to initiate the discussion.

Unit 2 - External assessment: 2 hours (40%)

Section A (20%) – Reading (40 marks) Understanding of at least one description, one narration and one exposition text, including continuous and non-continuous texts, assessed through a range of structured questions. This section will also include an editing task (2.5% of qualification total).

Section B (20%) – Writing (40 marks) One writing task to be selected from a choice of two that could be: either description, narration or exposition. This section will also include one proofreading task focusing on writing accurately (2.5% of qualification total)

Unit 3 - External assessment: 2 hours (40%)

Section A (20%) – Reading (40 marks) Understanding of at least one argumentation, one persuasion and one instructional text, including continuous and non-continuous texts, assessed through a range of structured questions.

Section B (20%) – Writing (40 marks) One compulsory argumentation writing task and one compulsory persuasion writing task. Half of the marks for this section will be awarded for communication and organisation (meaning, purpose, readers and structure) and the other half for writing accurately (language, grammar, punctuation and spelling).

Progression Routes / Careers

A good qualification in English Language is essential in all careers as an excellent standard of both written and spoken communication is vital. From mechanics to teachers, journalists to doctors, everyone needs an A*-C in this subject to progress on the career ladder.

Studying the course will enable learners to understand that texts have been influential and significant over time and explore their meaning today. Candidates will be encouraged to explore how texts may reflect or influence values, assumptions and a sense of identity. They will be taught how to connect ideas, themes and issues, drawing on a range of texts; become critical readers of fiction and non-fiction prose, poetry and drama as well as studying films. The course presents an opportunity to experience different times, cultures, viewpoints and situations in a variety of literary contexts. They will be able to respond to themes, plots, characters, dialogue and background through the study of visual and written literature.

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1: Poetry (25%)

Written Paper 1½ hours

Poetry

Candidates will be expected to appreciate and compare one of the set poems alongside an unseen poem.

Unit 2: Novel (25%)

Written Paper 1½ hours

Novel

Structured questions to assess understanding of the set texts

Unit 3 : Visual literature

Oral Examination - (25%) - approximately 20 minutes for each group

Study of film and literary text

Candidates will be examined in groups of three on a visual literary text

Unit 4: Non-examination assessment: Written Tasks (25%)

Candidates will be assessed in two tasks:

ENGLISH LITERATURE



Examination Board - WJEC

Course Summary

The GCSE specification in English Literature, available to all students, enables learners to explore how texts from different cultures and traditions may reflect or influence values, assumptions and a sense of identity. It is designed to allow students to become critical readers of fiction and non-fiction prose, poetry and drama, whilst experiencing different times, cultures, viewpoints and situations as found in literary texts. A new addition to the syllabus is the chance to appreciate Wales' cultural heritage through the study of Welsh writing in English.

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1 Prose (different cultures) and Poetry (contemporary): 2 hours (35%)

Section A 21% Different Cultures Prose: Of Mice and Men (Steinbeck). One extract analysis question and a choice of essay.
Section B 14% (COMPARATIVE STUDY) Contemporary: Unseen poetry comparison, the preparation for which will include the study of contemporary poems.

Unit 2 Literary Heritage and Contemporary Prose: 2 hours (40%)

English/Welsh/Irish Literary Heritage Drama: Othello (Shakespeare); OR Much Ado About Nothing (Shakespeare); OR An Inspector Calls (Priestley); OR Hobson's Choice (Brighouse); OR A Taste of Honey (Delaney). One extract analysis question and a choice of essay (20%).

Contemporary Prose: Paddy Clarke, Ha Ha Ha (Doyle); OR Heroes (Cormier); OR Never Let Me Go (Ishiguro); OR About a Boy (Hornby); OR Resistance (Sheers). One extract analysis question and a choice of essay (20%).

Unit 3 Shakespeare and Welsh Writing in English (25%)

Section A: Shakespeare Essay (12.5%)

A play by Shakespeare chosen by the centre (but not Othello or Much Ado About Nothing). WJEC will set a generic task on a specific theme which centres may use or modify.

Section B: Welsh Writing in English Essay (12.5%)

Stipulated poetry from the Library of Wales anthology Poetry 1900-2000: One Hundred Poets from Wales. Candidates study fifteen specified poems listed for the chosen theme. WJEC will set generic tasks on the theme. Centres may use or modify one task. Centres must ensure that the task requires comparison of at least two poems.

Progression Routes / Careers

Careers linked closely with good qualifications in English Literature are: the field of media and journalism; publishing, advertising and PR; teaching and lecturing; designing and writing publicity materials for museums, art galleries, festivals and events; becoming a press officer for national organisations and charities. The possibilities are endless.

ART AND DESIGN



Examination Board - WJEC

Course Summary

The course gives opportunities to follow a programme which encourages creativity, sustained investigation, experimentation, design and making as a means of developing technical and expressive skills, extending experience and personal response, as well as developing imagination and critical, reflective thinking. Thus, students will have the opportunity to develop a wide range of essential skills required for further and higher education, as well as employment. The internally assessed units encourage adventurous and open programmes of study that promote purposeful exploration, experimentation and opportunities for productive personal expression.

Assessment Details / Method

The specification is designed to encompass four principal areas for critical, practical and theoretical study of art, craft and design. These emphasise the qualities of analytical understanding, practical experimentation, researching and individual expression required at GCSE level. The assessment objective are as follows:

AO1 Critical understanding

AO2 Creative making

AO3 Reflective recording

AO4 Personal presentation.

Unit 1 Portfolio (60% of qualification)

This unit is designed to enable students to effectively develop an introductory foundation of core skills and encourage engagement with exciting creative experiences which build fundamental learning, knowledge, contextualisation skills and critical thinking. The time available for this unit also provides opportunities to focus on the acquisition of valuable skills (which include experimentation, drawing, the application of the formal elements and the ability to analyse and synthesise information and ideas) as well as to develop and refine techniques.

The Portfolio is internally assessed and externally moderated. Work produced for this unit will be assessed in relation to all four assessment objectives.

Unit 2 Externally Set Assignment (40% of qualification)

Students will develop their response over a preparatory period of six weeks. Responses must take the form of critical, practical and contextual preparatory work and/or supporting studies, which will inform the resolution of these ideas in a sustained focus study. Following the preparatory study period, students will be allocated a period of 10 hours sustained focus study to realise their response unaided and under supervised conditions.

Progression Routes / Careers

By following a degree course in Art and Design, there are several career paths open to you, working as one of the following: professional artist, community artist, architect, interior designer, photographer, animator, artistic manufacturer, product/fashion designer, creative practitioner, freelancer, curator, art and design administrator, primary or secondary teacher, subject to gaining a PGCE.

Course Summary

This course is only available through the medium of Welsh.

Three skills will be assessed:

- Appraising 30%
- Performing 35%
- Composing 35%

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1: Performing (35%)

Performing Skills (30%)

A practical examination that is assessed internally and moderated externally. The candidate will have to:

- Sing or play a solo part and
- Sing or play a part as a member of an ensemble/group (this performance must last at least 1 minute).

Students must prepare a minimum of two pieces. Both pieces must last between 4-6 minutes.

One of the pieces must link to an area of study.

Students are able to complete the Performing aspect using their voices alone: they do not have to play an instrument. Grade 3 or above is the expected standard.

We have fantastic peripatetic teachers in school each week to help with the preparation for the Performance aspect of the subject.

Programme Notes (5%)

Students must create programme notes on one of their performance pieces.

Unit 2: Composing (35%)

Composing Skills (30%)

During the course, the candidate will have to compose 2 contrasting pieces with a total playing time of 3-6 minutes. The compositions will be assessed internally and moderated externally. One of the pieces must be in response to a brief set by WJEC. The second composition is a free composition for which learners set their own brief. There will be ample opportunity for the students to work on their compositions in class, under the guidance and supervision of the teachers.

Evaluating composition (5%)

Pupils must produce an evaluation of the piece composed in response to a brief set by WJEC

Unit 3: Appraising (30%)

Examination: Listening Paper (June Year 11) 1 hour.

In this examination, the candidate will be analysing and evaluating music using musical terminology.

The questions will be based on 4 areas of study:

- Musical Forms and Devices
- Music for Ensembles
- Film Music
- Popular Music

Two of the eight questions will be based on prepared extracts (set works) set by WJEC.

Progression Routes / Careers

Music GCSE is a natural route into AS and A Level Music and is also a natural route for students who are creative and enjoy working in teams, who enjoy Performing on an instrument or singing. The course is also ideal for students who enjoy extensive listening to Music.

Course Summary

WJEC GCSE Geography adopts an enquiry approach to the study of geographical information, issues and concepts. It is based on the principle that geographical education should enable learners to become critical and reflective thinkers by engaging them actively in the enquiry process. Content is organised around key questions and learners should be encouraged to pose geographical questions of their own.

Fieldwork is an essential aspect of geographical education and of this qualification. It is placed at the heart of this specification and teachers should embed fieldwork within any programme of study that they create. Learners should consolidate and extend their understanding of geographical concepts learned in the classroom by engaging with enquiries conducted outside of the classroom and school grounds.

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1: Changing Physical and Human Landscapes

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes

40% of qualification 83 marks

Section A: Core Themes

Two structured, data response questions assessing Core Theme 1 (Landscapes and Physical Processes) and Core Theme 2 (Rural-urban Links).

Section B: Options

One structured question (from a choice of two) assessing either Theme 3 (Tectonic Landscapes and Hazards) or Theme 4 (Coastal Hazards and their Management). These themes provide additional breadth of study for the content assessed in the core themes.

Unit 2: Environmental and Development Issues

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes

40% of qualification 83 marks

Section A: Core Themes

Two structured, data response questions assessing Core Theme 5 (Weather, Climate and Ecosystems) and Core Theme 6 (Development and Resource Issues).

Section B: Options

One structured question (from a choice of two) assessing either Theme 7 (Social Development Issues) or Theme 8 (Environmental Challenges). These themes provide additional depth of study for the content assessed in the core themes.

Unit 3: Fieldwork Enquiry

Non-examination assessment: 2 hours 30 minutes

20% of qualification 44 marks

Unit 3 requires a written report from the learner, to include evidence of their understanding of the enquiry process and their independent ability to process/present data and complete extended writing. The report must be written in response to specific questions set by WJEC.

Progression Routes / Careers

Geography is a contemporary, exciting, and comprehensive subject that can lead to a range of careers e.g. environmental engineering, planning, surveying, media work and many more. The list is endless.

Examination Board - WJEC

Course Summary

The GCSE course allows students to have a taste of all of the elements associated with Theatre; acting, directing and designing. Due to the nature of the course, students have the flexibility to study the elements that appeal to them as individuals and it is possible to be assessed as an acting or a technical student. However, all students must be willing to perform to a certain degree in class whilst studying the set text as this will be studied practically, but technical students will not be assessed on their performing ability. It is expected that students frequent the theatre regularly and commit to extra hours after school during the periods of the practical exams. This subject offers the opportunity to students to develop strong communication skills as well as the self-confidence that is needed to succeed in any field of employment for the future.

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1: Devising Theatre

Non-exam assessment: internally assessed, externally moderated (40% of qualification)

Learners participate in the creation, development and performance of a piece of devised theatre based on either the work of a theatre practitioner or a genre in response to a stimulus set by WJEC. Such styles vary from Theatre in Education to Physical Theatre and from Musical Theatre to Pantomime. Students can choose the style that appeals to them individually. Learners will be assessed on either acting or design (lighting/sound/costume/set). Learners work in groups of between two and five performers.

Learners will complete a written evaluation of the devised performance under formal supervision.

Unit 2: Performing Theatre

Non-exam assessment: externally assessed by a visiting examiner (20% of qualification)

Learners participate in a performance based on two 10 minute extracts from a performance text of their own choice. Learners will be assessed on either acting or design. Learners work in groups of between two and four performers.

Unit 3: Interpreting Theatre

Written examination: 1 hour 30 minutes 40% of qualification 60 marks

Section A: Set Text - A series of questions on one set text explored as an actor, designer and director from a choice of five:
I|Romeo and Juliet William Shakespeare | 100 Imaginary Body | 1984 (George Orwell), adapted Robert Icke and Duncan Macmillan | Dau Wyneb Manon Steffan Ros | Cysgod y Cryman (Islwyn Ffowc Elis), adapted Sion Eirian.

Section B: Live Theatre Review requiring analysis and evaluation of one live theatre production seen during the course.

Progression Routes / Careers

Studying Drama at GCSE level keeps the options open for any field in the future. Past Drama students have moved on to study a variety of courses at Sixth Form and university level; courses that vary from Media Studies to Law, from Theatre Studies to Medicine. Opting to study a subject like Drama alongside more traditional subjects shows that a student has the ability to think creatively, work well with others and to communicate confidently on various levels. The skills developed in Drama therefore are applicable and valued in all areas of employment.

DESIGN AND TECHNOLOGY



Examination Board - WJEC

Course Summary

The syllabus is based upon the view that Design and Technology is essentially a practical activity and is concerned with developing the competencies necessary to address a wide variety of design situations. The course is organised so that the candidates are given the opportunity to undertake design activities in a range of home, school, recreation, community, business and industrial contexts. They should have the opportunity to analyse and evaluate situations, design and make artefacts which meet human needs and then appraise their performance. The new focus area of Product Design will offer candidates the opportunity to work in both Graphic Products and Resistant Materials Technology. There will be the opportunity to explore and make using an array of materials including Wood, Metal, Plastics as well as SMART materials, Card and Paper.

Assessment Details / Method

Unit 1 - Written Examination: 2 hours

There is a written examination which tests pupils' knowledge on designing, making and other issues concerning the environment. A mix of short answer, structured and extended writing questions assessing candidates' knowledge and understanding of Product Design.

Unit 2 - Design and Make task approximately 35 hours.

Assessment Objectives

Design

- i) Identifying design possibilities. ii) Developing a design brief and specification.
- iii) Generating and developing design ideas.

Making

- i) Making a prototype. ii) Evaluating a prototype's fitness for purpose

Progression Routes / Careers

GCSE in Design and technology offers a specialist vocational focus specifically in resistant materials for students. Students can progress naturally to relevant qualifications in this sector e.g. AS/A Level in Design and Technology.

Course Summary

You will enjoy the GCSE course if you wish to study a subject which gives you the opportunity to:

- undertake a variety of activities on topics that include the media, leisure activities, education, jobs, tourism and travelling, social activities, fitness and health;
- develop your communication skills, your thinking and problem-solving skills and ICT skills;
- discover more about other people, countries and cultures;
- develop your confidence in expressing your opinions and discussing ideas and viewpoints and deal with real-life situations.

Assessment Details / Method

You will be assessed equally on the 4 skill areas:

Speaking

You will take part in one oral test conducted in school by your teacher in which you will take part in describing a photo, role-play situation and two short conversations. (Worth 25% of your grade)

Writing

You will sit a written exam that includes two short written tasks and a translation into French/Spanish. (Worth 25% of your grade)

Reading

You will study a variety of articles and answer questions on them in Welsh and French/Spanish. There will also be a short translation into Welsh. (Worth 25% of your grade)

Listening

You will listen to a CD of a variety of passages and conversations and answer questions on them in Welsh and French/Spanish (Worth 25% of your grade)

You will be able to sit either Foundation Level or Higher Level in each of the four skills.

Progression Routes / Careers

We offer AS and A2 courses for French and Spanish if you wish to continue your studies following the completion of your GCSE course. Modern foreign languages qualifications are appreciated and respected by universities, whatever your choice of degree may be.

- Modern Foreign Languages are one of the 8 'facilitating' subjects looked upon favourably by the Russell Group of Universities (a group which consists of the 20 leading UK universities, and which includes Cardiff University).
- Foreign languages are also useful and important for the world of work, especially for business and leisure and tourism. Over 500 companies operating in Wales are foreign-owned and many other Welsh companies trade with foreign countries.
- 75% of British senior executives are looking to employ school-leavers who are competent (not necessarily fluent) in a foreign language.*
- 48% of British businesses are currently recruiting some staff specifically on the basis of their foreign languages skills, and of those, 50% require French speakers whilst 37% are looking for Spanish speakers.*

Unit 2 - Promoting and maintaining health and well-being

Non-exam assessment: approximately 25 hours (60% of award qualification) - 120 marks

This non-exam assessment (NEA) is composed of two tasks set by WJEC. Candidates may carry out their research for both tasks without direct supervision, prior to writing up their reports. Candidates should spend approximately 25 hours in total writing up their NEA reports, completing the work under supervised conditions within the centre.

Mae gan y cwsr llwybr dilyniant eglur drwy Lefel 2 a 3 mewn Gwaith Saer, Gosod Brics neu Gynnal a Chadw. Gall cwblhau'r cwsr arwain at ddysgu amser llawn mewn crefft ddewisol neu brentisiaeth yn y diwydiant adeiladu.

CONSTRUCTION SKILLS



Examination Board - City and Guilds and WJEC - Equivalent to 2 GCSE grades

Course Summary

The subject will be taught through the medium of Welsh only.

The syllabus is based upon the view that Construction Skills are practical skills; the course will be mainly practical based and taught at Coleg Ceredigion's purpose-built workshops on the Cardigan campus. The qualification is suitable for learners who wish to gain an insight into a number of construction related disciplines and subjects. Learners will explore the trade techniques of Carpentry, Bricklaying and Plastering. They will learn introductory practical skills together with essential theoretical knowledge and understanding to work safely, plan basic construction projects and complete work to a good standard in the construction industry.

Assessment Details / Method

There will be continuous practical assessment throughout the course. There will be written assessments for two units and individual unit evidence will be recorded within a portfolio. As well as course work and controlled tasks there will be a 1 hour external exam on Health & Safety as well as some short external assessments.

Progression Routes / Careers

The course has a well-defined pathway of progression through Levels 2 and 3 in Carpentry, Bricklaying or Maintenance. Completion of the course can lead on to full-time learning in a chosen trade or apprenticeship opportunities within the construction industry.

If you are interested in a career in the agriculture and countryside industries, then this would be a suitable course for you. It provides you with the opportunity to develop initial skills as well as developing an understanding and knowledge of how to work safely on a farm or country estate.

Assessment Details / Method

In BTEC all units are internally assessed. There is a mixture of practical and written assessments.

Assessment for BTEC qualifications is criteria referenced, based on the achievement of all the specified learning outcomes.

Each unit within the qualification has specified assessment and grading criteria, which are to be used for grading purposes. A summative unit grade can be awarded at pass, merit or distinction:

- to achieve a pass a learner must have satisfied all the pass assessment criteria.
- to achieve a merit a learner must additionally have satisfied all the merit grading criteria.
- to achieve a distinction a learner must additionally have satisfied all the grading distinction criteria.

The overall mark will be calculated on a points system at the end of the course.

Progression Routes / Careers

After studying this course, students can progress onto a full-time land-based level 3 course within the college, or onto A-levels.

If moving forward with studies is not of interest, students will have a good foundation to most farming systems and therefore going to work on a farm would definitely be an option.


